Lesson 1

Can I read and understand a piece of text?



Easter is an important Christian festival. It is when Christian people remember the death and **resurrection** of Jesus who they believe to be the son of God.

Most Christian people refer to the week before Easter Sunday as Holy Week. During this week, Christian people remember the last week of Jesus' life. Holy Week contains many special days for Christian people and it begins with Palm Sunday.



Palm Sunday

The Bible says that Jesus and his **disciples** entered Jerusalem on this day. Lots of people had heard that Jesus was about to arrive so a large crowd had gathered to welcome him. As Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey, the crowd took palm leaves from the trees, laid them on the ground for him to walk on and waved them in the air in celebration.

Maundy Thursday

On this day, Jesus and his disciples gathered together to eat their last meal together, known as The Last Supper. As his friends gathered at the house, Jesus surprised them by washing their feet and told them that they should always love one another. Jesus then passed bread and wine around the table. He explained that his friends should share bread and wine to remember him after his death.



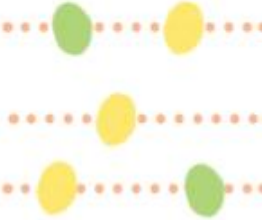
Good Friday

It was on Good Friday that Christians people believe that Jesus died. Jesus was made to carry a heavy wooden cross through the city to the place where he would be crucified. The Roman guards nailed Jesus to the cross and placed a crown made of thorns on his head.



Holy Saturday

According to the Bible, it was on this day that Jesus' body was placed in a tomb. A heavy stone was rolled in front of the tomb's entrance and it was guarded by a Roman soldier so that nobody could take his body.



Easter Sunday

Easter Sunday is a happy day for many Christian people because it is the day that they believe Jesus rose from the dead. The Bible says that the tomb of Jesus was found empty when his friends and family went to visit it. That same day and for 40 days afterwards, Jesus' disciples saw him and realised that God had raised him from the dead.

To celebrate Jesus' resurrection, special church services are held on this day. Gifts and Easter eggs are given and the church is filled with flowers which represent new life.

Glossary

disciples: followers of Jesus during his lifetime.

resurrection: rising from the dead.


