The main aim of the campaign is to get and keep people moving whilst trying to have some fun!

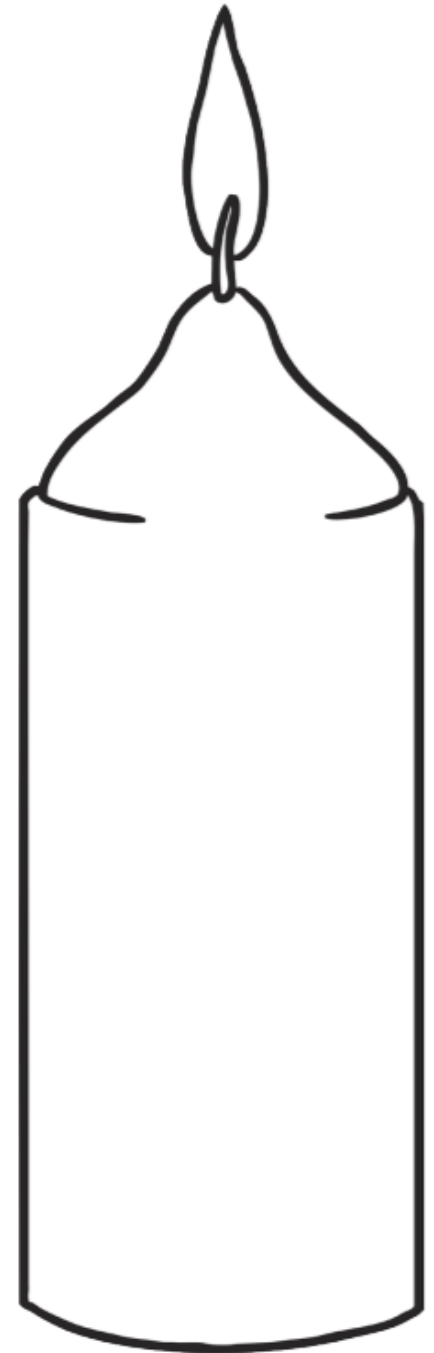
Art - Design a candle for Captain Tom

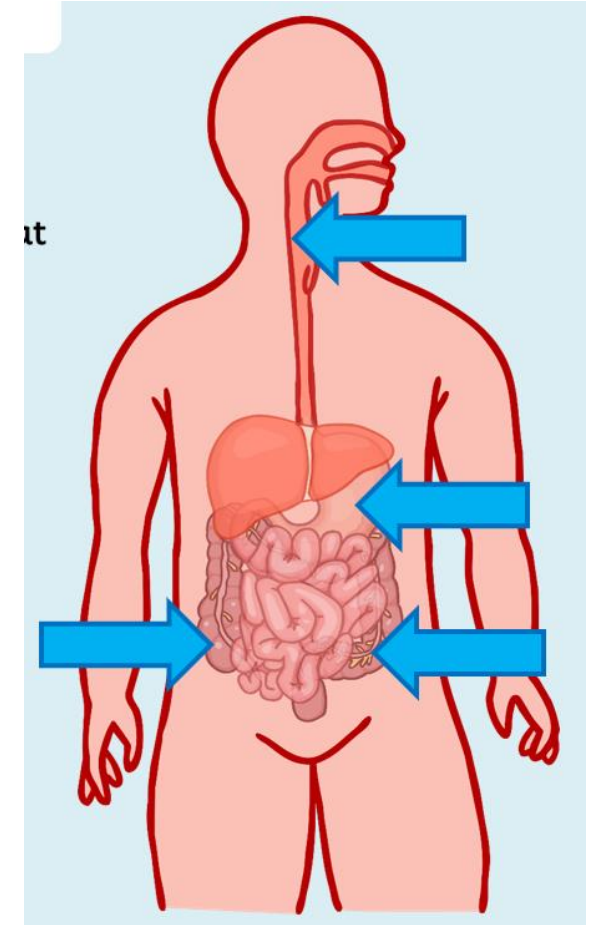
